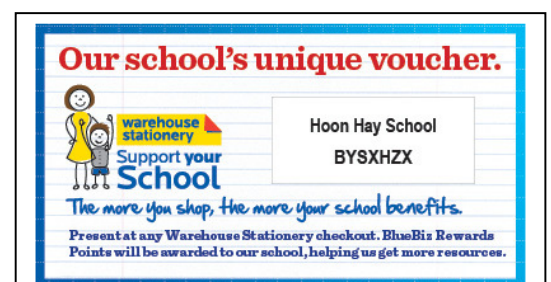

Ultraset

This is a website based system and there is a per pupil charge of \$5.

Ultraset is a Learning Management System that has 3 areas:

- ◆ webspace this is the main site area that hosts the web pages and has some modules available for public access.
- ◆ ClassSpace – these are virtual classrooms, which are the main hub from which teachers can share digital resources, host collaborative talks and publish learning content.
- ◆ uSpace – this is a unique area that houses our social learning network, where Ultraset users can access individual profile pages to publish and share their own content.

Ultraset is the first in a series of steps that we will take to build a community wide elearning environment. This is the way of the future and we look forward to jumping on board the ultraset journey!

Hoon Hay Sports Initiative 2012
