Please note: Crayons will be shared, please give them to your teacher.

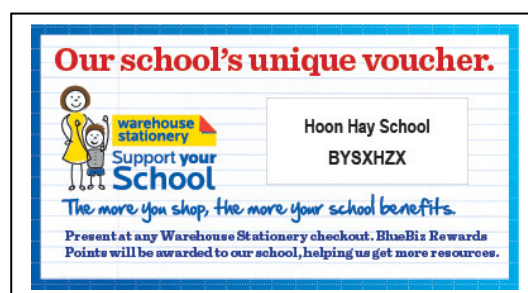

Ultranet

This is a website based system that is being introduced to our school next year and there is a per pupil charge of \$5.

Ultranet is a Learning Management System that has 3 areas:

- ◆ webspace this is the main site area that hosts the web pages and has some modules available for public access.
- ◆ ClassSpace – these are virtual classrooms, which are the main hub from which teachers can share digital resources, host collaborative talks and publish learning content.
- ◆ uSpace – this is a unique area that houses our social learning network, where Ultranet users can access individual profile pages to publish and share their own content.

Ultranet is the first in a series of steps that we will take to build a community wide elearning environment. This is the way of the future and we look forward to jumping on board the ultranet journey!

Hoon Hay Sports Initiative 2012

Hoon Hay School has joined with a number of other local schools to apply for funding to promote sport, sports skills and a strong sense of community.

Our application asks for partial funding to assist us with 3 main areas:
